

PLAID PHONICS IS A PROGRAM WHICH HELPS STAFF MEET
STUDENTS WHERE THEY ARE AT IN THEIR READING JOURNEY.
STUDENTS AT JOUSSARD SCHOOL ARE SUPPORTED AT THEIR
READING LEVEL IN ORDER FOR THEM TO WORK TOWARDS GRADE
LEVEL AND BEYOND. PLAID PHONICS IS AN INSTRUCTIONAL TOOL
THAT IS USED IN HPSD SCHOOL TO ENSURE THIS SMOOTH
TRANSITION FOR ALL STUDENTS FROM GRADE LEVELS AND
SCHOOLS.



BEGINNING WITH PHONEMIC AND PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS, PLAID PHONICS BUILDS FOUNDATIONAL PHONETIC SKILLS IN GRADES K-3. IN GRADES 4-6, THE INSTRUCTIONAL FOCUS TRANSITIONS FROM PHONICS TO WORD STUDY, INTEGRATING WRITING, SPELLING, READING, AND VOCABULARY PRACTICE.
